- 3) Key Points/actions from last meeting (15 minutes)

- b. Waiting on school corporation to give us new plates for the smaller trailer (title has been signed over) *A. Richardson still working on this.*
- c. Big trailer (older one) decals removed. A. Richardson and husband are working the decal removal. A. Richardson has asked anyone willing and have time to assist to please help. More time consuming than originally thought.
- d. Uniform cleaning: Still in process of being cleaned at E. Carlton's house.
- 4) Band Director Report (15 minutes)
 - a. Marching Band parent meeting had a few parents in attendance and B. Pickett was notified of some who could not attend and sent the marching band forms home with students.
 - b. B. Pickett shared information on two different trip possibilities to Nashville next year. The Band Boosters are very interested, and B. Pickett will gather more information regarding cost.
 - c. Drum Major Camp \$175.00, which will be \$87.50 for half of the minicamp since Simon is unable to attend the full week camp.
 - d. Received the new WGI plaque; however, it was wrong because once it was hung it would be upside down. Therefore, B. Pickett received a free new replacement.
 - e. Received all show patches!

 - g. Drill writer for marching show will be \$1,000.
 - h. Planning to use uniforms again from last year and only order additional ones for color guard, if needed.
